



Guidance for West Sussex Scout leaders for completion of questionnaires for Integrated Prevention and Earliest Help referrals

We have been successful at gaining further funding to continue our work supporting children that have been referred by what was Think Family which has been amalgamated with over services to form one service known as Integrated Prevention and Earliest Help, IPEH for short.

As part of this funding we must complete questionnaires with the young person to show the journey that they have been on since joining us.

What does this mean for you?

- You will receive a questionnaire to be completed with the young person at investiture. This is to be completed with the young person as part of conversation, not just handed to them to complete
- The questionnaire is scaled from 1 – 10 with 1 being the worst and 10 being the best. It is quite simple and intuitive to complete. The questions will need to be read and explained to younger children to allow them to give the most accurate response
- Complete a second form with the same questions approximately three months after they have been with the section
- All completed questionnaires to be returned to West Sussex Scouts County Office

It is likely that you will only need to complete two questionnaires but if there is need for further questionnaires as the family is still being worked with they will be sent at three-month intervals.
